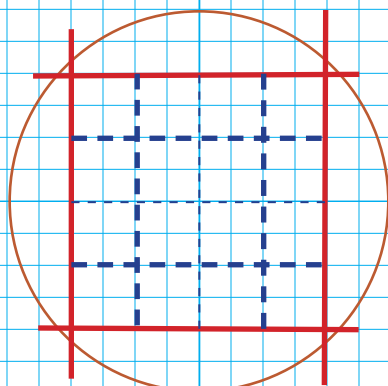
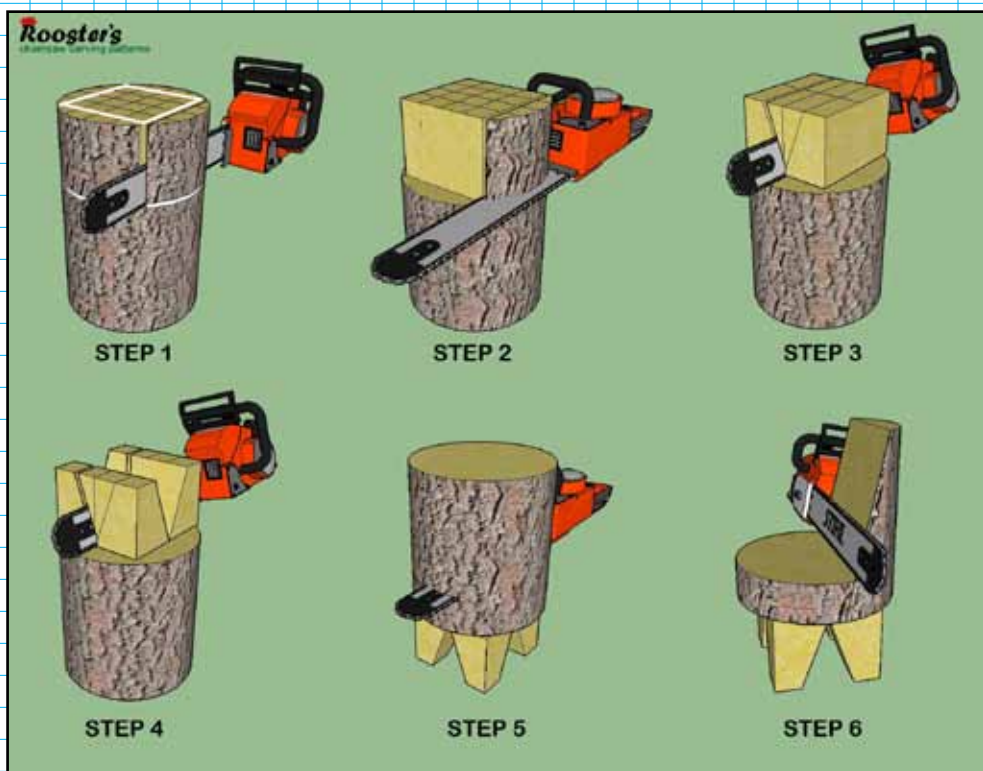
## EASY CHAIR

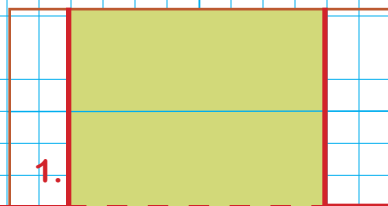

Step one is optional. Chainsaw "Sawying" pioneer Ray Murphy recently carved one in 7.5 seconds during his show in Maine.

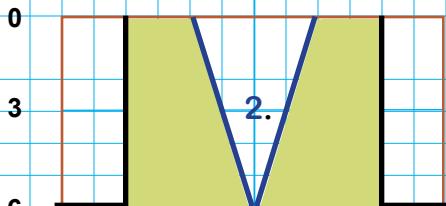

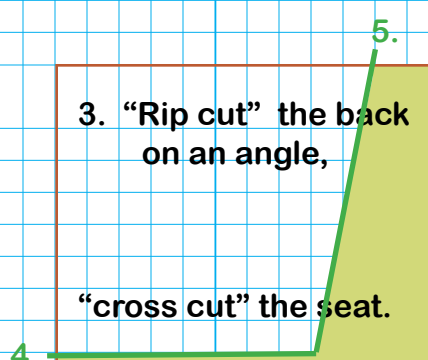
1. Mark a chalk line six inches down, all around.
