



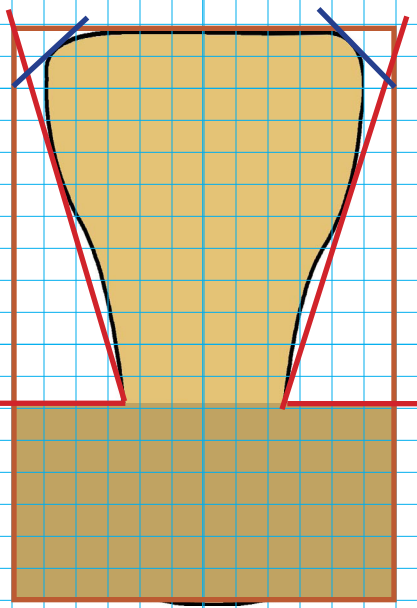
Barre Pinske is a carver in Cheater Vermont and is well known in the carving world for his artistic creativity and "off the wall" sense of humor.

Barre 'cooks' his rough outs to control checking. He "burns" the surface with a welding torch, then power brushes to remove the char, giving a raised grain effect.

The final finish is automotive paint then "dry brush" technique to emphasize the raised grain.

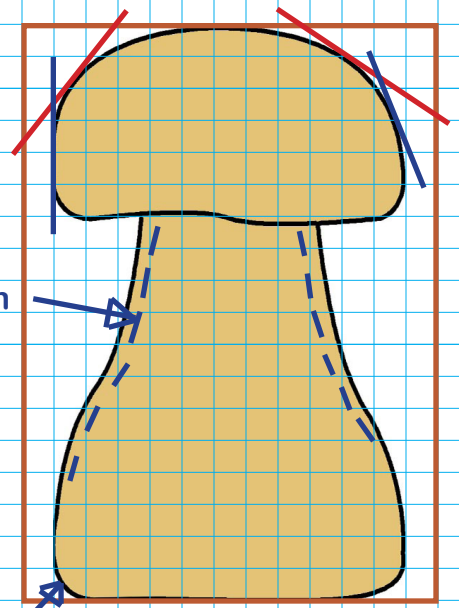
